




Burton Constable Company of Bowmen

A Recurve bow has tips that curve away from the archer when the bow is unstrung. When strung a Recurve stores more energy than an equivalent straight limbed bow and therefore offers more thrust to project the arrow through the air to the target.



Riser

The riser on the modern bow could also be called the handle. It is the central component of the bow placed between the limbs, and it is where all other major components attach, it is usually constructed out of machined aluminum and/or carbon fiber.
